Halloween Ball

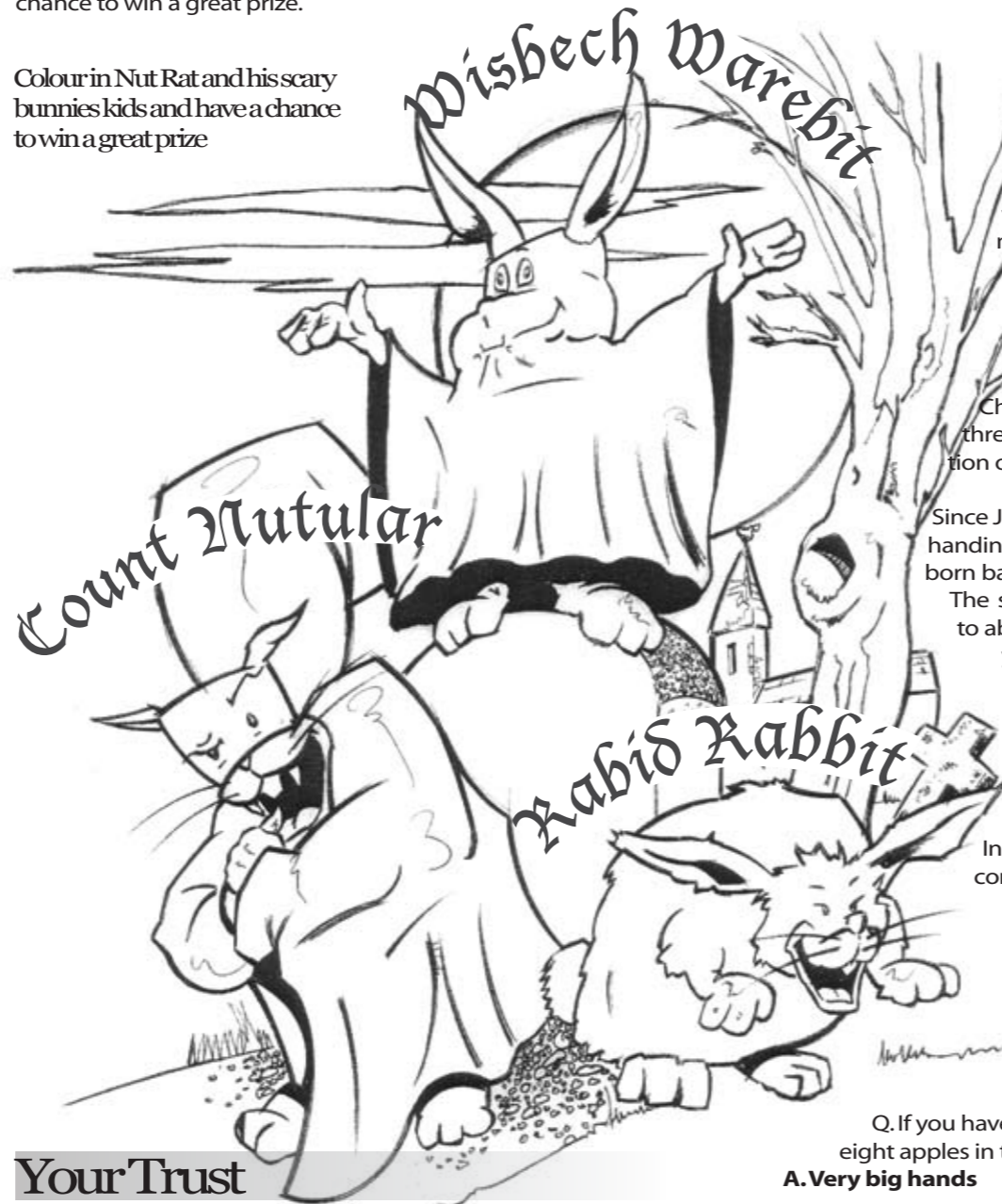

Nursery News

The Wisbech Mayor came along to see the children at the nursery and looked at the mobile library which parks at the Oasis Centre. The Oasis Nursery team are encouraging the children to read and become interested in books.

The children were presented with their very own collection of books from the mobile library.

Cambridgeshire County Council's library has a regular stop-off at the centre but this was a special visit.

Children between the ages of two and three years were given a **Bookstart** collection of books.

Since January 2006 council libraries have been handing out three book-based gifts to new-born babies and toddlers up to the age of four. The scheme provides free reading material to about 20,000 children in the county each year.

Children's centre manager Sharron Bowman, said: "The nursery will continue to encourage the children's developing interest and enjoyment of books."

In September the library service, in conjunction with the centre have started a



Bookstart club for babies up to 14 months' old every Thursday at 2pm.

Already on Tuesdays there are sessions for 14 month to three-year-olds, called Oasis Play, which promotes learning and reading skills.

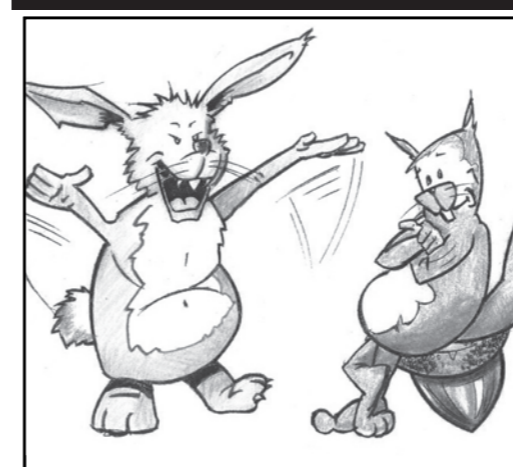

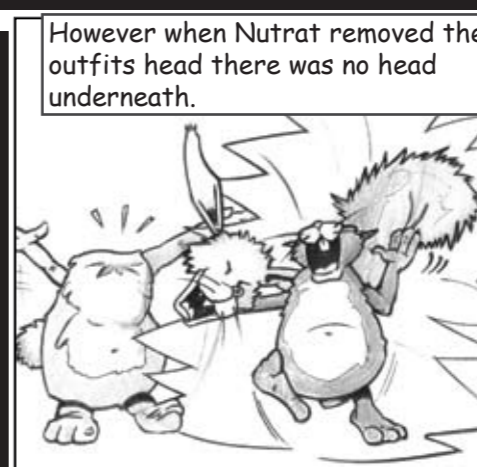

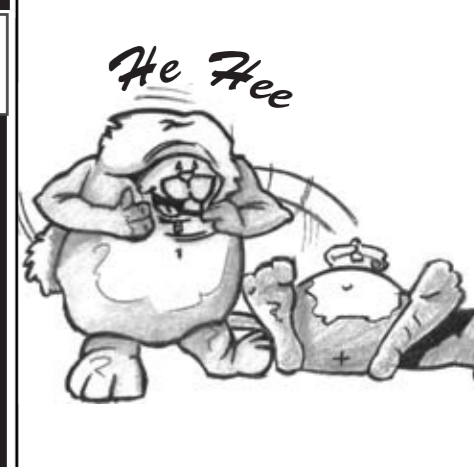
