## Age Concern

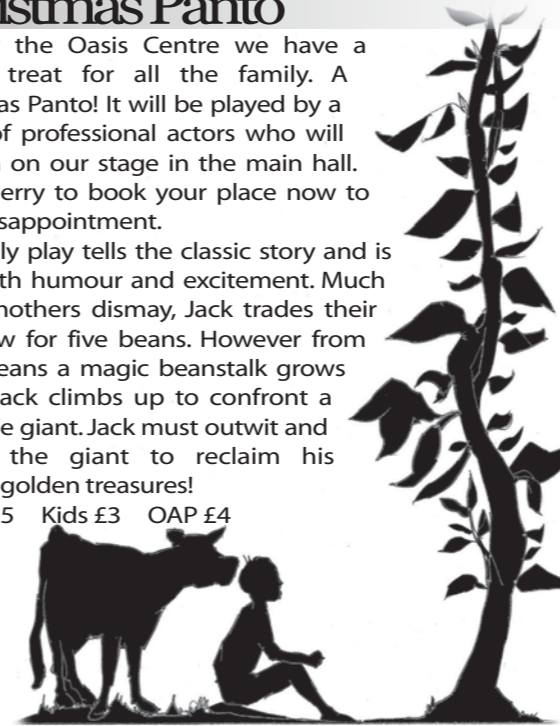

Needless to say, she was disappointed and started to cry. The clerk, trying to console her, said,

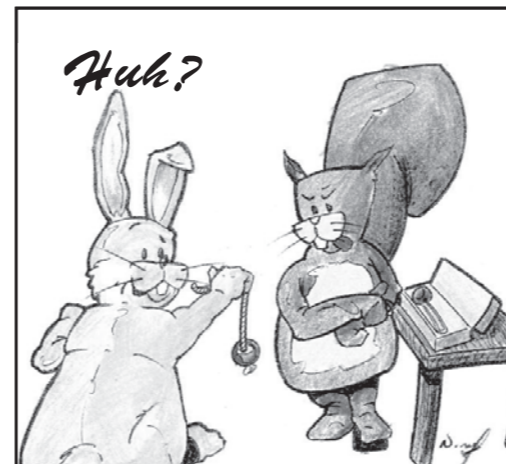

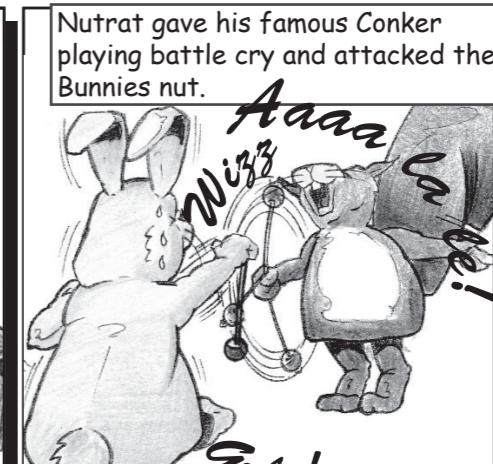
