Nutrat and the Roundabout Bunnies...

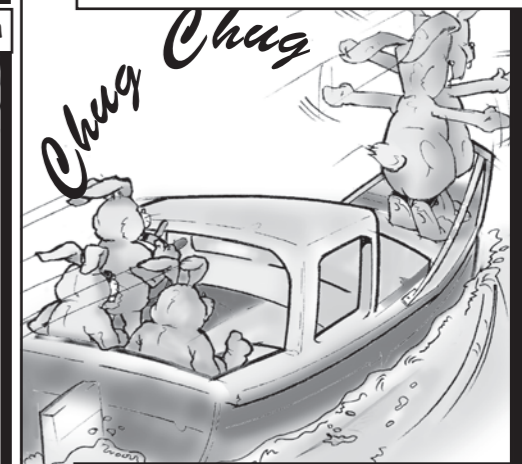


The Council were so happy with all the hard work the rabbits had done on the Roundabout keeping it neat and tidy.
